Offence : U/s 341, 324 and 294(b) r/w 34 IPC  
Order : Bail application is allowed.

**ORDER**

1. This is an application filed u/s 480 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

2. The petitioners are accused Nos. 2 and in C.C. No. 133/2023. The offences alleged against the petitioners are punishable under Sections 341, 324, and 294(b) read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code. In connection with the above crime, the petitioners have been in judicial custody since 18.10.2025.

3. The prosecution allegation is that at about 11.00 a.m. on 26.10.2022, at Chundakolly, Pulpally Amsom, the accused persons herein, along with the other accused in this case, in furtherance of their common intention, wrongfully restrained the first informant and abused him by uttering obscene words.

Further, the accused voluntarily caused hurt to him by scratching him with a broken beer bottle. Thus, the petitioners are alleged to have committed the aforesaid offences.

4. The learned counsel for the petitioners/accused submitted that the petitioners are innocent of the allegations levelled against them. The petitioners have been in custody since 18.10.2025. It is further submitted that there are solvent sureties willing to vouch for the petitioners' appearance before the court, and they are ready to abide by any condition imposed by this Court if they are released on bail. Hence, the learned counsel for the petitioners/accused prays that they may be released on bail.

5. Notice of the application was given to the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

6. Heard and perused the records.

7. It is noted that the petitioners/accused have been in custody for the last eight days. After perusal of the records, this Court is satisfied that the investigation of the case has been completed and the final report has already been filed before this Court. Hence, this Court is of the view that further detention of the petitioners in custody is not necessary. Accordingly, the bail application is allowed subject to the following conditions:

In the result, the application for bail filed by the petitioners/accused is allowed on the following conditions:

1. The petitioners/accused shall execute a bond for ₹25,000/- (Rupees Twenty-Five Thousand only) each, with two solvent sureties each for the like sum.
2. The petitioners shall not commit any offence while on bail.
