1. Vide separate order of even date announced in the open Court, the cognizance of the offence has been taken.
2. Ld. Counsels for some of the accused persons submit that that some more time may be given for scrutiny of documents as the record of the charge-sheet is bulky and matter may be posted for arguments on the point of Charge after scrutiny is complete.
3. The similar record (charge-sheet and documents) which has been filed before this Court was provided to Ld. Counsels for accused persons through a pendrive on 06.08.2026. Sufficient time has already been given to Ld. Counsels for scrutiny and till date, no written request has been made by anyone of them about supply of any

deficient/illegible copy. However, in the interest of justice, all Ld. Counsels are given liberty to bring it to the notice of the Court if the record received by them does not contain any specific document/documents or any illegible copy/copies. The IO is directed to immediately provide the deficient copy/copies, if any, to the Ld. Counsels for accused persons if same is pointed out by them in writing.

4. Keeping in view the facts & circumstances, now the matter is being listed **for arguments on the point of Charge.**

5. **Put up for arguments on the point of Charge on behalf of prosecution on 13.08.2026. All the accused persons are remanded to JC and be produced through VC on 13.08.2026.**

6. Reader has reported that custody warrants of accused persons have not been produced today by the jail authorities due to Independence Day security arrangement. Jail authorities are directed to produce the same on 13.08.2026 and copy of this order be sent to the jail authority by email for information and compliance.
