Documents also stated to that effect. The petitioner also states urgent grounds that he will be ousted if the interim exparte order is not passed. Also found that there has to be an urgent order in order to preserve the rights of the parties for adjudication. Hence I find that there has to be an ad-interim exparte injunction order restraining the

respondent and their men from forcefully dispossessing the petitioner and from petition B schedule property and also from causing any hindrance to the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petition B schedule property by the petitioner.
