



(Anuj Satendra Saxena Vs. State of Maharashtra)

**Order below Exh.01 in Cri. Bail Application No.326/2026**

(Passed on 16.06.2026)

This is an application under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 by the Applicant Anuj Satendra Saxena seeking his release on pre-arrest bail in the event of arrest in respect of Crime No.12/2025 for the offence under Sections 318(4), 336(3), 340 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 read with Section 66(D) of the Information Technology Act, registered at Cyber Police Station, Ahilyanagar. As his name features in F.I.R., he apprehends arrest.

2. Perused the application, say filed by the learned APP for the State and Informant. Heard learned Advocate for the Applicant, learned APP for the State and learned advocate for the Informant. I have perused the documents at Sr.No.1 to 9 filed along with list Exh.03.

3. I have studied Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 as well as Sections 318(4), 336(3), 340 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 read with Section 66(D) of the Information Technology Act. I have also studied the case laws of ***Ayush Malhotra Vs. State of Haryana 2026 Supreme(Online) (P&H) 6737*** and ***Ashok Kumar Vs. State of NCT of Delhi in Bail Application No.40/2026 dated 22.04.2026***. The case laws are become profitable to me.

4. After going through the F.I.R. and documents filed by the

parties, it is appear that, the huge amount is involved in the cheating. It is also necessary to investigate that, the bank account hold by the applicant is used as tool or the helping hand to espouse the ill-motive of the defrauder. If applicant has not provided his bank account to the defrauder, the said offence is not would have been taken place. Hence, investigation to that effect is necessary. For that, custodial interrogation is warranted. Considering the role of the Applicant in the alleged offence, I am on the opinion that, Applicant is not entitled for the pre-arrest bail. Hence, following order is passed.

**ORDER**

1. The Criminal Bail Application No.326/2026 stands rejected.
2. The proceeding is closed.
