

heard and disposed of by the Commercial Court exercising territorial jurisdiction over such arbitration where such Commercial Court has been constituted.

4) From the above provisions, what can be gathered is that, if the subject matter of an arbitration is commercial dispute of a specified value, then the Commercial Court has jurisdiction to decide all applications or appeals arising out of such arbitration. The said case is filed under section 9 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act against the award passed by the Arbitral Tribunal. Commercial Court is established at Ahmednager and Ld. District Judge is designated as Commercial Court. Therefore, as the application is under Arbitration and Conciliation Act and it is a commercial dispute between the parties of more than a specified value. Therefore, this court finds that, it does not have jurisdiction to decide the said case and it is to be decided by the Commercial Court. Hence the order :-

ORDER

Office to make a report to the Hon'ble Principal District Judge to transfer the said case to the Commercial Court.
