ORDER BELOW EXH. 17 IN CIVIL M.A. NO. 248/2024
(Karan Rajendra Mane Vs. Salim Bashir Shaikh & Ors.)

1. This is an application by respondent no.3 Insurance Company for setting-aside ex parte order.
2. It is contended that notice of the delay condonation application was served upon it but, at the relevant time, there was internal meeting called by the officers of respondent no.3 Company for the purpose of plan of action for closure of pending the matters. So also, some of the Senior Officers left the job. Therefore, it took time for new officers to take charge of the matters. There was heavy work load. Hence, the officers of respondent no.3 failed to appoint for representing the matter. Thus, prayed for ex parte order be set-aside.
3. The applicant filed say and contended that necessary order may be passed.
4. Heard both the sides. The present application has been filed by the applicant for condonation of delay caused in filing Motor Accident Claim Petition against respondent no.3 Insurance Company as well as driver and owner of the offending vehicle. Respondent no.3 Insurance Company is necessary party to decide the issue involved in the matter. Therefore, considering the reason mentioned in the application and in order to decide the matter on merits, it will be just and proper to

set-aside exparte order. Hence, the application deserves to be allowed.

Accordingly, I pass following order;

ORDER

1. Application is allowed.
2. The exparte order dated 08.08.2025 against respondent no.3 Insurance Company is hereby set-aside.
