The accused No.12 Govardhan Sahadu Shinde has filed present application for grant of permission to travel abroad.

2. According to accused No.12, he wants to go to Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand during the period from 14.03.2026 to 24.03.2026. He has filed an application (Exh.569) for grant of passport which was allowed on 01.11.2025 by this Court. However, the Court has ordered to obtain permission before traveling abroad. It is submitted that his learned advocate will conduct the matter in his absence and he will not challenge his identity in his absence. He further submitted that after returning from abroad, he will remain present in the Court on fixed dates. Therefore, permission may be granted for traveling abroad.

3. Ld. APP has not objected the application as the learned advocate for accused No. 12 will conduct the matter in the absence of accused No. 12.

4. Heard both sides. It appears from the record accused No. 12 has filed this application and prayed for permission to travel abroad from 14.03.2026 to 24.03.2026.

5. From perusal of the application and submissions therein, the accused No. 12 wants permission to travel abroad. He submitted that he

will not challenge his identity in his absence and his learned advocate will conduct the matter in his absence. As such, I find that it will not cause prejudice to the prosecution. In the present facts and circumstances, it will be justified to grant permission to accused No. 12 to travel abroad. Hence, the order.

ORDER

1.	Application is allowed.
2.	The applicant / accused Govardhan Sahadu Shinde is allowed to travel abroad i.e. Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand from 14.03.2026 to 24.03.2026.
3.	The applicant / accused No. 12 to deposit Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupees One lakh only) as additional cash security which will be returned to him after his arrival from abroad.
4.	The applicant / accused No. 12 is directed to furnish the itinerary to the Court before 48 hours of departure.
5.	The applicant / accused No. 12 is directed to furnish two references along with their consent, who can be contacted in his absence by the police department.
6.	After arrival, the applicant / accused No. 12 to intimate this Court immediately.
7.	The applicant / accused No. 12 shall not seek adjournment or dispute his identity during the course of inquiry or trial.
