ORDER BELOW EXH.01

The present matter is filed by the complainant under Section 138 of The Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. As there was chances for amicable settlement between the parties, the matter was referred to the Mediator through District Mediation Center, Ahmednagar.

2] Report of mediation of Mediator Judge is received vide **Exh.60** which shows it is successful and also filed pursis at **Exh.61** stating that the matter is settled between the accused and the complainant and the complainant do not want to proceed further with the complaint and the complaint be disposed of. In view of unconditional withdrawal pursis filed vide **Exh.61**, no purpose would serve to keep pending the present complaint. Hence, the present complaint deserves to be disposed of. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order :

ORDER

- 1] The matter is disposed of as withdrawn in view of unconditional withdrawal pursis at **Exh.61**.
- 2] The accused **Yogesh Balasaheb Jadhav, Proprietor of Chhatrapati Car Decor** is acquitted for the offence punishable u/s. 138 of The Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881.
- 3] Bail bonds of the accused are cancelled.
- 4] Court fees be refunded as per rule.
