By this application, the accused wants Court to cancel N.B.W. issued against her on the ground that, she could not remain present due to marriage of her daughter at her native place in Punjab. The Exh.37 is for minimum penalty for forfeiture of the bond. The complainant objected the application on the ground that she breached the condition of bail. Hence, application may kindly be rejected.

2. Perused the record.

3. Heard the learned Advocate from the both the sides. They argued according to their application and say.

4. After having gone through the record, it appears that, the case is stalled due to absence of the accused since 06.06.2024. Though the reason mentioned in the application appears to be probable, the case would have been continued in her absence by her learned Advocate. But that did not happen. Therefore, it has to be said that the case is delayed due to absence of the accused.

5. Considering the reason mentioned in the application, nature of the offence and stage of the case the N.B.W. is required to be cancelled with

penalty. Hence, the N.B.W. stands cancelled subject to penalty of Rs.2,000/-. The accused be released upon furnishing fresh P.B. and S.B. of Rs.15,000/-. Inform to concern Police Station. Copy of this order be placed below Exh.37.
