

ORDER PASSED BELOW EXH.157

The present suit is of year 2000. It is pretty old. As per directions of Hon'ble High Court and Sessions Court the old matters shall be disposed off as early as possible.

2. The present application is filed by plaintiff seeking direction to be given to defendant no. 12 to 14 for the production of sale deed of the suit property from their custody. Perused the application and say filed by defendant no. 12 to 14.

3. Learned advocate Shri. A. Z. Gandhi submitted that the original sale deeds are in the possession of defendant no. 12 to 14. Therefore, direction may be given to defendant no. 12 to 14 for the production of sale deed i.e., 3633/2013, 3641/2013. He further submitted that after the production of sale deeds he will give evidence affidavit of plaintiff.

4. Learned advocate Shri. S. H. Gonge for defendant no. 12 to 14 submitted that the application is false and frivolous. The plaintiff may get certified copies of sale deed from the concerned office. Therefore, the application may be rejected.

5. Considering the circumstances, the plaintiff may obtain certified copies of sale deeds from the sub-registrar office and may

lead secondary evidence. Therefore, I pass the following order,

ORDER

1. The application is rejected.

2. Both parties are hereby directed that considering the age of suit both parties shall co-operate for the disposal of the suit.
