

ORDER BELOW EXH.47

1. This is an application filed by defendant Nos.2-A and 2-C for permission to file written-statement on record.
2. Read the application. Plaintiff opposed the application. Heard both sides. Perused record. The defendant Nos.2-A and 2-C have not filed their written-statement on record within statutory period.
3. Perusal of the record, it shows that plaintiff's relief is specially against defendants. The plaintiff has filed this suit for declaration and permanent injunction. So for proper adjudication of the matter, it is necessary to go through the contention of defendant Nos.2-A and 2-C.
4. Moving of this application, it shows that defendant Nos.2-A and 2-C is willing to contest the matter. Hence, granting opportunity to them would not caused any prejudice to the plaintiff. Hence, as it is necessary for fair trial, both the parties must be given opportunity to prove their cases. Therefore, in the interest of justice the following order is passed.

1. The application is allowed subject to cost of Rs.500/- paid to plaintiff.
2. Permission is granted to the defendant Nos.2-A and 2-C for filing W. S.
