State of Maharashtra,

Balu Vilas Supekar and Ors.

Order Below Exh.26

1. This is an application filed by the applicant/accused no.1 Balu Vilas Supekar for No objection for issuance of new passport.
2. Perused the application and say filed by learned APP. Heard both the sides.
3. It is submitted by the applicant that he is permanent resident of Varje Malwadi, Ramnagar Shivaji Chauk Tawar, Pune. He filed application for issuance of new passport. Passport authority sought NOC of this Court. Thus, prayed to issue NOC for issuance of new passport.
4. On the other hand learned APP objected this application on the ground that the offences are serious in nature. If permission is granted to obtain passport to the applicant, he will abscond. Thus, prayed to reject this application.
5. Considering the rival contentions of both the sides, I carefully perused the record. It appears that the applicant is the accused in RCC no.345/2025. The applicant is alleged to have committed an offence punishable u/s. 498-a, 323, 504, 506 read with 34 of the IPC. Charge is already framed. Trial would take its own course.

6. It is to be noted that the right to travel abroad forms part of Fundamental Rights, guaranteed under the Constitution of India. By this application applicant/accused no.1 seeking NOC for obtaining new passport. Therefore, under these circumstances, if NOC is granted to the applicant /accused no.1 to obtain new passport with condition not to travel abroad without the permission of the Court, it would meet the ends of justice. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

:: ORDER ::

1. The application is hereby allowed.
2. The passport authority may issue passport to the applicant/accused no.1 Balu Vilas Supekar as per rules.
3. Applicant/accused no.1 is directed not to travel abroad without the permission of the Court.
