ORDER BELOW EXH-1 IN CRI. BAIL APPLICATION

NO.47/2026.

**(Rajendra @ Raju Sudhakar Jagtap Vs. State of
Maharashtra)**

Applicant/accused Rajendra @ Raju Sudhakar Jagtap has prayed for regular bail U/Sec. 483 of B.N.S.S., 2023 in CR No.I-438/2025 registered with Sonai Police Station for the offence P/U/Secs. 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5), 324(3) of B.N.S., 2023 and U/Secs. 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of SC & ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

2] Heard adv. Shri. P. C. Nahar for the accused and SPP Shri. M. P. Gavate for the prosecution.

3] IO has opposed the application.

4] The allegations against the accused are that he has caused damage to the informant's vehicle and threatened her. Looking to the nature of the offence made against the accused, his further detention does not seem necessary nor it will serve any purpose.

In the result, I pass the following order :

ORDER

1. Criminal Bail Application No.47/2026 is allowed.
2. Accused accused Rajendra @ Raju Sudhakar Jagtap, be released on bail in sum of Rs. 25000/- with one surety in like amount in CR No.I-438/2025 registered with Sonai

Police Station for the offence P/U/Secs. 352, 351(2), 351(3), 3(5), 324(3) of B.N.S., 2023 and U/Secs. 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va) of SC & ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

3. Accused should not contact the prosecution witnesses in any manner nor should tamper the prosecution evidence.
