

ORDER BELOW EXH-1 IN CRI. BAIL APPLICATION NO. 64/2026.

(Manoj Rambhau Shinde Vs. State)

1. This application is for regular bail U/Sec. 483 of BNSS.
2. Victim is a girl aged about 14 years.
3. On 02.03.2026, at about 7.30 a.m. victim was going to school. Accused came across her while victim was in front of school. Accused urged her that they would go to Shevgaon for troll. Accused said that he love her and that he would marry her. Accused asked her to come at a garage. Accordingly, victim had gone to that garage. They both started towards Shevgaon on motorcycle. During the journey, accused hugged her, kissed her.
4. Accused was arrested on 02.03.2026. He was produced before this Court seeking Police Custody for three days. However, he was remanded to Judicial Custody.
5. Victim is aged 14 years, accused is aged 22. On the askance of accused, victim had gone to the garage. Considering these aspects and considering the acts that are attributed to accused, detention of accused behind the bars is absolutely not necessary.

6. Ld. Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that accused and victim reside in the same village and there would be possibility of influencing victim.

7. Accused is labour. However, he has permanent place of residence. There are no circumstances that accused is living in vagrant situation. He will not flee away from justice. It will be proper to release him on bail on imposing necessary conditions. Hence, I pass following order.

:: ORDER ::

- 1) Accused **Manoj Rambhau Shinde**, is released on bail, in Crime No. 165/2026 of Newasa Police Station, on PB and SB of Rs.50,000/-.
- 2) Accused shall undertake to abide with following conditions
 - i) He shall not tamper prosecution evidence.
 - ii) He shall not make messages or calls to victim.
 - ii) He shall attend Police Station on every Monday from 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon till filing of the charge-sheet.
- 3) Bail in the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Newasa.
