

**Order Below Exh. 1 in Regular Civil Suit No. 200097 of 2014**

(Raju Wagh Vs. Balasaheb Zuge)

The instant application has been filed by the plaintiff for the correction in judgment passed in RCS No. 97/2014 under section 152 of the Civil Procedure Code.


2. Heard the learned advocate Shri. M. B. Deshmukh for the plaintiff. He submitted at bar that, in RCS No. 97/2014 the judgment was pronounced on 01/04/2026. On perusal of certified copy of judgment in RCS No. 97/2014 the number of the suit property bearing gat No. 109/1/B is inadvertently mentioned as gat No. 190/1/B. The said mistake is arithmetical in nature, which can be cured under section 152 of the CPC. Hence, prayed for arithmetical correction in judgment in RCS No. 97/2014.

3. After giving my thoughtful consideration to the contention canvassed by the learned advocate for the plaintiff and on perusal of record and proceeding in RCS No. 97/2014, it depicts that, the suit property is mentioned as land gat No. 109/1/B. On perusal of judgment in RCS No. 97/2014, it depicts that, in the first para of the judgment the suit property is mentioned as correctly as enumerated in plaint. But on perusal of para No. 24 of the judgment and operative order the suit property is inadvertently mentioned as gat No. 190/1/B instead of gat No. 109/1/B. The said arithmetical error can be cured by resorting to provision of section 152 of the CPC. Accordingly, I pass following order.

**ORDER**

In para No. 24 of the judgment and in operative order land gat No. 190/1/B is corrected as land gat No. 109/1/B.
