1. The instant application has been filed on the behalf of the plaintiff for amendment under Order VI, Rule 17 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

2. Heard learned advocate for the plaintiff. He submitted at bar that, the present suit is for declaration and injunction. He further submitted that, during the pendency of the suit the plaintiff has deposited court fee stamp. Furthermore, during pendency of the suit defendant No. 3 sold the suit property to the defendant No. 5. Hence, he wants to amend the clause Nos. 3, 4, 6 and 7b in plaint.
