



ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT 15 IN RCS 359/2021

This is an application filed by defendant Nos.1 to 4 for condonation of delay for filing their written statement on record.

2. The defendant Nos.1 to 4 in their application has stated that due to lockdown of Covid-19 they failed to collect the documents and therefore there is a delay to file their written statement. Hence, they have prayed to allow the application by condoning the delay and to have their written statement on record.

3. The plaintiff has filed her say on the application itself and contended that defendants were served with suit summons on 26/07/2021. The defendants have intentionally filed their written statement at belated stage. The application filed by defendants is false. Hence, prayed to reject the application. The plaintiff has further submitted that if the court allowed the application then heavy costs be imposed upon defendant Nos.1 to 4.

4. Perused the application and say. Perused the record of the case. For the purpose of deciding the real controversy between parties, it is necessary to have the Written Statement of defendant Nos.1, to 4 on record. Considering reasons as stated in the application, the application deserves to be allowed. No prejudice will be caused to the plaintiffs, if the application is allowed. Negligence on part of defendants can be compensated in terms of money. Hence, I proceed to pass following order :

ORDER

- i) The application is allowed subject to costs of Rs.200/- (Rupees Two hundred only).
- ii) Written Statement of defendant Nos.1 to 4 will be read and recorded on payment of costs of Rs.200/- (Rupees Two hundred only) to be paid to the plaintiff on or before next date.
