

**Order Below Exh.35 in R.C.S.No.689/2015**

1. The plaintiff moved instant application for carrying out amendment under Order VI Rule 17 of C.P.C. Same is supported by affidavit Exh.36 for bringing the two sisters of defendant nos.2 & 3. Their impleadment is necessary to determine the right and share of all stakeholders in partition of family property.

2. The defendant objected as the sisters have to be brought on record at the very inception. In alternative, prayed for costs.

3. On perusal of record, the present suit is for partition and declaration in regards family property through plaintiff's father. In my opinion, the proposed defendants are being sisters of defendant nos.2 & 3 and father of plaintiffs. Therefore, they are certainly having interest in family property. Thus, amendment is significant for deciding the real dispute between the parties on merit. The particulars of property is highly essential for adjudication. No prejudice will be caused to defendant side. In result, following order.

**Order**

- 1) Application Exh.35 stands allowed, subject to cost of Rs.150/- to be paid to defendant no.1.
- 2) Plaintiff shall carry out the amendment up to next date and comply the same.
