

**ORDER BELOW EXH. 34 IN RCS NO. 22/2018**  
(CNRMHAH1900 0111 2018)

01. The plaintiff has filed this application stating that name of defendant no. 6 to 8 be deleted from the suit title. Plaintiff submitted that she has not claimed any relief against defendant no. 6 to 8. Hence, the names of defendant no. 6 to 8 be deleted from the suit title. The application is supported with affidavit.

02. Defendant filed say overleaf the same application and submitted their no objection.

03. Heard. Perused record.

04. The suit is filed for partition and perpetual injunction against defendants. Evidence has not yet started in the suit. On perusal of record it seems that defendant no.6 to 8 are made party in the suit only because their names exist in 7x12 extract of the suit property as co-owners. Moreover, the plaintiff herself has submitted that she is not claiming any relief against defendant No. 6 to 8, hence, prayed to delete their names. The amendment sought is formal in nature. No prejudice will cause to either parties if the proposed amendment is allowed. So also, the nature of the suit will not change. Therefore, application deserves to be allowed. Hence, I pass the following order.

**ORDER**

(01) Application is allowed.

(02) Plaintiff is directed to carry out amendment as prayed within 14 days from this order.
