



**ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT No.1**

1] This application is filed as per section 503 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita by applicant namely **Sagar Devidas Thokal** for interim custody of ACCESS 125 DISC BT bearing registration No. MH-16-DL-9328, Engine No. AF213758004 and Chassis No. MB8DP12PHR8A56576 seized in C.R. No.1227/2025 registered with Pathardi police station, Tal. Pathardi, Dist. Ahmednagar.

2] Perused the application along with affidavit of the applicant thereon. Say of A.P.P. and Investigating Officer. Heard Ld. Advocate for applicant and A.P.P. for State.

3] According to the applicant police has seized his above numbered motorcycle in C.R. No.1227/2025 U/s 311, 310(2) of BNS. The said motorcycle is owned by applicant. It is further contended that the hearing of the case would take time. The applicant being the owner of the aforesaid motorcycle and entitle to its interim custody. It is submitted that if the motorcycle is remained in the police station premises, it will be damaged due to the reason of natural things, it will become useless and result into economic loss of the applicant. If the said motorcycle will be given in possession of the applicant, he is ready to obey the terms and conditions imposed by the Court.

4] Learned A.P.P. and I.O. have filed say and opposed the application contending that the said motorcycle is an important part of evidence and will be required during trial. If the motorcycle is released the applicant may use it for similar type of offence. The motorcycle is proceed of crime. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

5] Considering the submissions and evidence on record, it appears

that, the applicant is owner of the seized motorcycle. He is ready to abide with the conditions imposed by the Court. The applicant in support of his contentions has filed the documents i.e FIR, copy of Registration certificate, and copy applicant's aadhar card. It seen that applicant is registered owner of the motorcycle.

6] The Applicant is not an accused in the crime. Yet trial of the offence not commence and it will require its own time. Therefore, he is entitled for the interim custody of the motorcycle. In the result, I pass the following order.

**ORDER**

1. The application is allowed.
2. The interim custody of ACCESS 125 DISC BT bearing registration No. MH-16-DL-9328, Engine No. AF213758004 and Chassis No. MB8DP12PHR8A56576 seized in C.R. No.1227/2025 registered with Pathardi police station be handed over to the applicant **Sagar Devidas Thokal** executing indemnity bond of Rs.1,00,000/- as per section 503 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023.
3. The applicant to undertake that he shall not sell or transfer the above mentioned motorcycle without the prior permission of the court. The applicant to maintain and preserve the motorcycle in all respects.
4. The applicant shall produce the motorcycle in the court as and when directed.
5. Investigating Officer is hereby directed to prepare the panchanama of the said motorcycle and took its photograph.
