ORDER BELOW EXH.NO. 01 IN S.C.C. NO. 195/2024

The Hon'ble District Court Ahmednagar vide its letter bearing Outward No. D.L.S.A./795/2026 dated 18/02/2026 has informed to undertake special drives on the 05 working days prior to the National Lok Adalat i.e. from 09/03/2026 to 13/03/2026, to dispose of cases under Section 279 and 281 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Section 256 and 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973). Therefore today the present case is taken up in the Special Drive.

02] Perused the record and proceeding. On perusal, it appears that my Learned Predecessor as well as this Court has issued summons to the accused for securing his presence. Till today, awaiting summons report has not been filed on record. Thus, prosecution has failed to secure the presence of accused. Therefore, no purpose will be served by keeping the case pending for indefinite period. Thus, in aforesaid circumstances, it is fit case, where resort can be taken of the provisions enshrined under Section 281 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973). Hence, I pass following order:-

<u>:- ORDER :-</u>	
1]	The proceeding of this case is hereby stopped vide Section 281 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973).
2]	The Accused is discharged from the offence punishable under Section 185 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1989 vide Section 281 of the Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973), in this case.
3]	Bail bonds of the accused stands canceled, if any.
4]	Police papers be preserved in "C" File for next six months.
5]	Copy of order be sent to the concerned Police Station.
