



**ORDER BELOW EXH.29 IN R.C.S. NO.214/2019**  
**(Sangita Sudam Shinde Vs. Rangnath Tukaram Aadhav and others)**

1] The present application is moved by the defendant No.1, 3, 5, 6 and 10 to 12 for condonation of delay and for setting-aside no W.S order passed against them.

2] It is the contention of the defendants that, due to announcement of lockdown in the whole country, they failed to file their written statement within the prescribed period of limitation. Further submitted that, if No W.S order is not set aside, it will affect on merits of the case. Hence prayed for condonation of delay and for setting No W.S order.

3] The plaintiff has filed his say on the last page of this application through her advocate. She stated that, any just and reasonable order may be passed.

4] Considering the facts and circumstances, the reasons shown by the defendants for causing delay found to be genuine. But the delay is caused for filing written-statement is not in dispute. But, plaintiff should be compensated for the same. The plaintiff will not cause any prejudice, if the present application is allowed. Therefore, in view of the

above discussion, in order to avoid multiplicity of the proceeding and in the interest of the justice, fair chance be given to the defendants on payment of costs to the plaintiff. In the result, I pass following order.

**-: O R D E R :-**

1. The application (Exh.No.29) is hereby allowed on payment of costs of Rs.200/- (In words Two Hundred Only) in total payable to the plaintiff till next date.
2. After payment of the said cost, the written-statement of the defendant No. 1, 3, 5, 6 and 10 to 12 for be taken on record.
