

**ORDER BELOW APPLICATION VIDE EXH.17**  
**IN R. C. S. No.285/2015.**

1) The defendant no.1 is filed present application for setting aside no W.S. order passed against him. It is the contention of defendant that the documents for filing W.S. were not available to him and he failed to file his say and W.S. within limitation.

2) The plaintiff filed say on the back side of this application and strongly objected the application that defendants filed false application and prayed for rejection of application about the setting aside no W.S. Order.

3) Heard learned advocate Mr. N. P. Kulkarni for defendant No. 1 and learned advocate Mr. P. V. Deshmukh for plaintiff. Considering the rival contention of the parties, the following points arise for my consideration and I have recorded my finding alongwith reason as below.

1. Whether no W.S. Order passed against defendant no. 1 is liable to set aside ?

**REASONS**4) **AS TO POINT NO.1 AND 2.**

It is the contention of defendant no. 1 that the important documents were not available to him and he failed to file his written statement within limitation. On the contrary the plaintiff objected the application that false application is filed and prayed for rejection of application.

5) Considering the nature of suit an opportunity to be heard should be given to the defendant. If opportunity will be given to the defendant no. 1, the plaintiff will not suffer any irreparable loss. The plaintiff can be very well compensated by affording costs upon the defendant. Hence considering submission and for proper adjudication in the interest of justice no W.S. Order passed against defendant no. 1 is liable to be set aside. Hence I give finding to point no.1 in the affirmative and in answer to point no.2 I proceed to pass following order.

**ORDER**

1) The application vide exh. 17 is allowed subject to costs of Rs.200/- (Rupees Two Hundred Only).

2) The defendant no. 1 to pay costs to the plaintiff.
