**I S S U E S**

- 1] Whether plaintiffs prove that, they are lawful owner and in settled possession over the suit property as described in the claim ?
- 2] Whether plaintiffs prove that, the boundaries of the suit property are disputed or uncertain, requiring demarcation ?
- 3] Whether plaintiffs prove that, demarcation and fixation of boundaries of the suit property through Dy. S. L. R., Shrigonda is necessary ?
- 4] Whether plaintiffs are entitled to demarcation and fixation boundaries of the suit property as prayed for ?
- 5] Whether the defendants No. 1 to 3 (plaintiffs in counter-claim) prove that, they are in lawful possession of the counter claim property as described in counter claim ?
- 6] Whether the defendants No. 1 to 3 (plaintiffs in counter-claim) prove that, plaintiffs (defendants in counter-claim) have attempted or are attempting to interfere with their possession of the counter-claim property ?
- 7] Whether the defendants No. 1 to 3 (plaintiffs in counter-claim) are entitled to relief of permanent injunction as prayed in counter-claim ?
- 8] Whether the defendants No. 1 to 3 (plaintiffs in counter-claim) prove that, the plaintiff's suit is not maintainable as framed ?
- 9] Whether the defendants No. 1 to 3 (plaintiffs in counter-claim) prove that, boundaries are already fixed and correctly reflected in the revenue records and hence demarcation of boundaries of suit property is not required ?
- 10] What order and decree ?
