



**ORDER BELOW EXH.5 IN R.C.S. NO.345/2021**  
**(Bapu Baba Mane Vs. Santosh Manik Bhondve and others)**

1] Present application is filed by the plaintiff for granting Ex-parte temporary injunction against defendants for restraining defendants from causing unauthorized obstruction to the peaceful possession of plaintiffs over the suit property.

2] Learned Advocate for plaintiff Shri. S. D. Borude argued that, present suit is filed for measurement, fixation of boundaries and permanent injunction. Further argued that, now defendants are trying to cause unauthorized obstruction over the suit property. If defendants are not restrained from obstructing then plaintiff will suffer irreparable loss and there would be complications in the suit. Prima-facie case is made out. Thus, he prays to grant Ex-parte ad-interim injunction against the defendants to restrain them from causing unauthorized obstruction to the peaceful possession of plaintiffs over suit property.

3] Read application and affidavit of the plaintiff. Perused all documents produced along with list Exh.3. Heard Learned advocate appearing for plaintiff at length. No prima-facie urgent case is made out. Also, Considering the nature of dispute, it is necessary to hear the defendants before passing any Ex-parte order on this application.

Hence, following order.

**-: ORDER :-**

1. Issue show cause notice to the defendants that why Ex-party temporary injunction should not be granted against them, Returnable on 12/11/2021.
2. Urgent E.P and S.B is allowed.
