**ORDER BELOW EXH. 1**

This is a suit for partition. Plaintiff and Defendants were present before the court. They are identified by their learned advocates. They were referred for mediation. Mediator has forwarded his report about amicable settlement between the parties. Parties have filed on record compromise deed (Exh.16). The contents of compromise were read over to the parties to which they have admitted its contents to be true and correct. As per the terms of compromise the parties have divided the suit property between themselves. Therefore, terms of the compromise are legal. Hence, said compromised deed (Exh.16) was read and recorded. On perusal of the same, dispute between the parties is amicably settled out of the court. Hence, I pass following order;

**ORDER**

1. The suit is disposed off in view of compromise deed (Exh. 16).
2. Court fees, if any, be refunded as per rules.
3. Draw decree in terms of compromise deed (Exh.16).
4. Parties shall bear their own costs.
