Today, the present petition is fixed for final argument. During argument it revealed that the present petitioner being aggrieved by order dtd. 23.11.2024 passed by Ld. JMFC Akola in RCC No. 1076/2021 has moved the present petition. In fact, by said petition he challenging the order of rejection of his discharge application moved before Ld. Magistrate. It also appears that in the present petition only the prosecution i.e. the State has made the party. In my considered opinion by any order in the present petition the original informant and victim is going to be affected.
