

Criminal Appeal No.117/2026
(Sagar S/o Arvind Bhirad .Vrs. Tushar S/o Arun Dharaskar + 1)

ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NOS. 05 and 13
[Passed on 12th May, 2026]

The appellant (Original accused) Sagar S/o Arvind Bhirad has preferred this appeal against the judgment and order of conviction passed by Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate (Court No.3), Akola by judgment dated 03.02.2026 in Summary Criminal Case No.2994/2022 under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act. The appellant has filed application for suspension of sentence at Exhibit 5 along with application for releasing him on bail at Exhibit 13.

2) Heard Learned Advocate for the appellant. It is seen that compensation amount is not paid by the appellant in learned Trial Court till today. He was sentenced to suffer S.I. for a period of six months and to pay compensation amount of Rs.1,00,000/-. He was on bail during the trial. Hearing of appeal may take long time. No purpose will be served by taking the appellant in custody. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1] The application Exhibit 5 and 13 are allowed.
- 2] Execution of sentence passed by Learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, (Court No.3), Akola against the appellant (original accused) Sagar S/o Arvind Bhirad in Summary Criminal Case No.2994/2022 by judgment dated 03.02.2026 is hereby suspended till

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final decision of appeal subject to condition that the appellant be deposit 20% of total compensation amount imposed upon him by the learned Trial Court within sixty days from today.

- 3] The appellant shall furnish P.B. and S.B. of Rs.25,000/- (Rs. Twenty Five thousand only)
- 4] Inform the learned Trial Court.
