This is an application for preliminary objection for dismissal of the claim on the point of limitation.

2. It is the say of opponent No.3 that objection is not filed within 06 months from the date of cause of action. Hence, prayed to dismiss the claim petition.

3. Claimant filed say that once the claim is registered it implies that the point of limitation is decided. Hence prayed to reject the application.

4. No one is present for applicants. Heard ld. Advocate for claimants.

5. The point of limitation is mixed question of fact and law. More particularly in view of section 159 of Motor Vehicle Act the concerned police officer in whose jurisdiction the accident occurred is under duty to prepare an accident information report within three months and has forward the same to the claims tribunal or the agency for facilitating the settlement of the claim. The applicant has no where mentioned about accident information. Hence these facts can be decided after trial. Hence, the order:

- ii] Respondent no.2 is directed to file W.S. without seeking further time.
