Witness Shri Sandip Patil P.C. B.No.1047 is present in Court today. He is on the point of carrying muddemal from Telhara Police Station to Forensic Science Laboratory Amravati. His duty pass is on record at page No.64. Ld. Advocate for the accused admitted the said duty pass hence it is marked as exhibit. Similarly, C.A. reports are admitted by the accused at Exh.87 to 90. In this premise, evidence of Shri Sandip Patil is not recorded.

2. Witness Vishal Sawarkar was issued with summons. Police Constable Bunde on behalf of serving officer Telhara Police Station states that, Vishal Sawarkar is avoiding service of summons and his family members are not giving information about him or his whereabouts. Therefore, there is reason to believe that, witness Vishal Sawarkar is intentionally avoiding the service of summons upon him and is getting absconded. Hence, issue bailable warrant of Rs.200/- against him.

3. Issue fresh witness summons to the victim and Neena Ramdas Gawale. Telhara Police Station is directed to take strict and positive steps to search and secure presence of the victim and Neena Ramdas Gawale.
