ORDER

Perused the record, it shows that there being *prima-facie* elements of settlement, the matter was referred for mediation to the Hon'ble Ld. Judge Mediator. Accordingly, the Hon'ble Judge Mediator forwarded his report (Exh.21) stating that the parties have arrived at amicable settlement during mediation process.

2. Having regard to the amicable settlement, the complainant filed *Pursis* (Exh.22) stating that in view of settlement before the Mediator, the complainant has received the disputed cheque amount. Therefore, the complainant does not want to proceed with the complaint. It is prayed to dispose of the complaint. The *Pursis* (Exh.22) is signed by the complainant and his Ld. Advocate. Therefore, considering Report (Exh.21) of Hon'ble Judge Mediator together with *Pursis* (Exh.22) voluntarily filed by the complainant, the case is required to be disposed of. Hence, I pass the following order ;

ORDER

- 1) In view of mediation Report (Exh.21) and *Pursis* (Exh.22) the complaint under Section

138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 stands disposed of as withdrawn under Section 280 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

- 2) The accused stands acquitted of the offence punishable under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 under Section 280 of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
- 3) Bail bonds of the accused stand cancelled.
- 4) Mediation report (Exh.21) and *Pursis* (Exh.22) shall be kept with (Exh.01).
- 5) Court fee if any, be refunded as per rule.
- 6) Proceeding stands closed.
