**ORDER**  
**(Below Exh. 27)**  
**(Passed on 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2026)**

This is an application to carry out amendment in the written statement consequential to the amendment carried out by the plaintiff in his plaint.

2. It is submitted by the defendant that the plaintiff by way of amendment corrected the date of the disputed sale deed described in his plaint. Therefore, the written statement of the defendant is required to be amended. Hence, it is prayed to allow the application.

3. Per contra, Ld. Advocate took objection and prayed to reject the application.

4. Heard both the sides. Perused the application, Say and documents on record.

5. Record shows that by way of order below Exh. 24, the plaintiff was permitted to amend his plaint with regard to disputed sale deed. Therefore, in the interest of justice, it is necessary to permit the defendant also, to carry
