1. Do the plaintiffs prove that the suit properties are ancestral properties of the plaintiffs and defendants ?
2. Do defendants No. 2,3,4,6,7 and 8 prove that suit property No.1 is self acquired property of Kashiram and suit property No.2 is self acquired property of Kashiram and Ravindra ?
3. Do defendants No. 2,3,4,6,7 and 8 prove that the plaintiffs and defendant no. 1 to 5 have waived their share in suit property No.3 in favour of Anil Kashiram Dobale?
4. Do the plaintiffs prove that the will-deed dated 16.6.2000 sale-deed dated 27.5.2003 and gift-deed dated 3.7.2008 are null and void and not binding on them
5. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to relief of declaration as prayed ?
6. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to relief of partition as prayed? If yes, what are the shares of respective parties ?
7. Whether the plaintiffs are entitled to relief of perpetual injunction as prayed ?
8. Whether the suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary party?
9. What order and decree ?
