

**ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN CIVIL MISC. APPLICATION NO.380/2025**

This is an application is filed for obtaining the heirship certificate as per the provisions of Section VIII(2) of Bombay Regulation Act.

2. The applicant submitted that, applicant are real sister. Their father namely Pralhad Atmaram Sapdhare was resident of Mundgaon, tq. Akot, dist. Akola. He was died on 10/10/2025 on the same address. The mother of the applicant namely Rukhamini Pralhad Sapdhare was died on 10/08/2024. The grandmother of applicant namely Bhagirathibai Atmaram Sapdhare was died long ago. The deceased did not having any legal heirs except the applicants. The applicants needs heirship certificate to submit before government, semi government offices. Therefore, prays to issue heirship certificate in their favour.

3. The applicant has made publication in daily news paper 'Dainik Siaran' dtd. 20/12/2025 and also made publication of citation notice inviting thereby the objections from the public at large with regard to issuance of heirship certificate. The copy of paper publication and report of citation notice is on record. However, no objections has been received during given period. Thus, the application remained uncontested. In support of application, the applicant No. 5 have examined himself at Exh.9 and witness namely

Chagan Dayaramji Ambalkar at Exh. 10. The applicant have produced death certificate of their father and copies of their Aadhar Card. The applicant No. 1 to 6 are appears to be daughter of the deceased. The mother of the deceased is appears to be dead. Therefore, the applicant is appears to be legal heirs of the deceased.

4. It is to be noted that, the Court of Civil Judge, Junior Division is only empowered to issue heirship certificate in uncontentionous matters and subject to its pecuniary jurisdiction only. In the present matter, the applicant claims heirship certificate to submit before government, semi government offices. It is settled principle laid down in various judgment of Hon'ble Bombay High Court that the certificate can be issued for purpose submitting before government, semi government offices. Therefore, in this matter the valuation of the application cannot be made in terms of money. Even it appears from the death certificate of the deceased that, he was permanent resident of Mundgaon, Tal. Akot, Dist. Akola. Therefore, it appears that, the present application is within the pecuniary and territorial jurisdiction of this Court. None other than applicants have made claim for heirship certificate. Hence, there is no hesitation to allow the application as prayed for, subject to the payment of necessary Court fees. Therefore, following order is passed :-

**ORDER**

1. Application is allowed.

2. Heirship certificate under Section VIII of Bombay Regulation Act,1827 be issued in favour of applicant as legal heir of deceased Pralhad Atmaram Sapdhare to submit before government, semi government offices.
3. Said certificate be issued subject to the payment of necessary Court fees by the applicant.
