

ORDER BELOW EXH. 20

(Passed on 17-10-2025)

This is an application filed by the decree holder (in short 'DH') for getting police aid for the execution of warrant issued under Order XXI Rule 43 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (in short 'CPC').

2. On going through the overall record and specifically the bailiff report dated 17.02.2020 it clearly appears that while doing the execution of warrant issued against judgment debtor (in short 'JD') vide Order XXI Rule 43 of CPC the obstruction is caused at the hands of family members of JD. In such circumstances for the proper execution of warrant police aid needs to be provided as sought.

3. Further despite of sufficient opportunity the JD has not filed his say to this application. Therefore, this application remained un-resisted by the JD. In such circumstances this application deserves to be allowed as sought. Hence, I pass the following order.

ORDER

1. Application (Exh.20) is hereby allowed.
2. The officer incharge of concern police station is hereby directed that he shall provide the proper police aid to decree holder for the execution of warrant under Order XXI Rule 43 of the Code of

Civil Procedure, 1908 issued by this court.

3. The decree holder is hereby directed to deposit the requisite fees for police aid directly in concern police station.
4. Issue letter to the officer incharge of concern police station, accordingly.
5. This is very old matter, therefore, it needs to be proceeded and disposed off expeditiously, so the decree holder is hereby directed to deposit the requisite fees for police aid directly in concern police station within period of 15 days from this order, failure to it this very old darkhast will be disposed off in default of decree holder.
