Examination-In-Chief By App Smt. S. R. Lokhande:-

1. I have completed MBBS and DCH from B. J. Medical College, Pune in the year 2015. I was serving as a medical officer at Balapur rural hospital from 2015 to Feb.-2020. On 23.03.2019 I was on duty. On that day, H.C., Shri. Mhatre B.No.716 brought me patient namely Murlidhar Shankar Wadekar, age 59 years R/o. Kanheri, Tq. Balapur, Distt. Akola with requisition letter for examination and medical treatment. The said letter was acknowledged by me by putting my signature. Now, I am shown the said letters which bears my signature and contents are true. The said letters are marked at **Exh. at 33.**

2. I medically examined patient Murlidhar Shankar Wadekar and I found Laceration on below eye, size 0.1 x 0.5 cm, fresh injury and the said injury was grievous in nature. I extended medical treatment and accordingly injury certificate. Now, I am shown the said injury certificate, bears my signature and contents are true and correct. The said certificate is marked at **Exh. 34.**

3. On 01.04.2019 P.C. Ravindra Aherkar produced Ironic Plier (पेन्चीस) weapon for my opinion. The said weapon was produced with letter which I acknowledged. Accordingly, I gave my opinion over the back leaf of the said letter for which injury caused to the patient namely Murlidhar Wadekar. Now, I am shown the letter which bears my signature contents are true and correct. The said

letter is marked at **Exh. 35**. Now, I am shown the opinion over the back leaf of the said requisition which bears my signature contents are true and correct. The opinion is marked at **Exh. 36**.

5. Now, I am shown Article 1 Plier. The injury mentioned at Exh. 34 may be possible with this Article 1.

Examination in chief is over.

Cross examination by Adv. Shri. S. T. Ingle:-

6. It is true to say that, at the time of examination of the patient the history of assault normally is ask, and if the patient did not narrate the history then it is not required to be taken down. Now, I am shown Exh. 34. It is true to say that, I have not written down history of assault. It is true to say that, as per the medical certificate I mentioned healing period for 3 days. It is not true to say that, in view of the healing period mentioned in injury certificate, the nature of injury appears to be simple in nature at Exh. 34.

7. It is true to say that, the mentioned at Exh. 34 may be possible if person felled upon sharp edge object. It is true to say that, as per the medical certificate the time of examination of patient was shown at 1 p.m.. It is not true to say that, without having examined patient Murlidhar Wadekar I issued injury certificate at the instance of the police. It is true to say that, I did not noticed any blood strain on the plier at Article 1 when it was produced to me for my opinion. It is true to say that, I left the second line of portion without mentioning the size of weapon and shown it blank. It is not true to say that, the police did not produced any weapon before me, therefore I failed to mention the exact size in my query report. It is true to say that, the said query report doesn't bear seal of the hospital. It is not true to say that, I issued injury certificate at Exh. 36 at the instance of the police. It is not true to say that, I deposed falsely.
