Examination-In-Chief By App Smt. Fauzia T. A. Saddique

1. I have completed MBBS and DCH from B. J. Medical College, Pune in the year 2015. I was serving as a medical officer at Balapur rural hospital from 2015 to Feb.-2020. On 01.07.2018 I was on duty. On that day, ASI PC Bharat, B.No.644 brought me Sukhram Shriram Telgote, aged 60 yrs., with requisition letter for examination and medical treatment. The said letter was acknowledged by me by putting my signature. Now, I am shown the said letter which bears my signature and contents are true. The said letter is marks and **exhibited at 49.**

2. I medically examined patient Sukharam Shriram Telgote and I found following injuries:-

i. Abrasion over skull on occipital region, size 2 x 2 cm caused fresh injury cause by hard and blunt object.

ii. Abrasion over right forearm, size 2 x 2 cm, fresh injury cause by hard and blunt object.

iii. Swelling over left leg, size 10 x 5 cm, fresh injury cause by hard and blunt object.

iv. Bleeding form right ear, laceration over ear and back side, fresh injury cause by sharp object. Healing period 7 days.

3. During examination I found that, patient was drowse and irrelevant talking, unable to walk and get properly. His pupils were dilated, smell of alcohol was present, fleshing of face appears. I come

to the conclusion that, though the patient was alcoholic state of mind but he was not under influence. Injury No.1 and 2 were simple in nature but injury No.3 and 4 are in grievous in nature. I had extended the patient for basic primary treatment and I refereed the patient to further medical treatment to GMC, Akola.

Since, muddemal is not produced before the court till, therefore the matter is kept in second session for further examination-in-chief.

Further examination-in-chief resume on oath:-

4. After, examination to the patient I issued injury certificate. Now, I am shown the said injury certificate bears my signature and contents are true and correct. The said injury certificate is marked at **Exh.50**. On 07.09.2018 I received a letter as to query in respect of injury cause to the patient namely Sukhram Telgote. The said letter was acknowledged by me. The police brought to me the weapon for purpose of my opinion along with this letter. Upon verifying the said Knife and wooden stick, I gave my opinion by writing down on the back leaf of the said letter. Now, I am shown the said letter which is the same and bears my signature, the contends are true and correct. The said letter is marked at **Exh.51**.

5. I clarified that, the said injuries can be possible by Knife and Wooden stick. Now, I am shown Article - ३ and ३ which are the same produced before me for my opinion. The injury No.4 can be possible to cause by Article ३ Knife. It is true to say that, the injury No.1 to 3 can be possible by Wooden stick i.e. Article ३.

Examination in chief is over.

Cross examination by Adv. Shri. R. N. Wankhade:-

6. It is not true to say that, at the time of examination I had just resumed my duty. I did not supply any document to the police as to showing my presence on 01.07.2018. It is true to say that, when patient had visited to me, he was drunken in state of mind. It is true to say that, patient was caught hold by two to four person when he had come to me. It is true to say that, injury No.1 to 3 can be possible if person fall by sleeping his leg over drainage line (नाली). It is true to say that, injury No.4 can be possible if person fall upon edged of drainage. It is not true to say that, I issued false certificate without examination of the patient. It is not true to say that, I deposed falsely. It is not true to say that, the opinion at Exh.51 to the letter dated 07.09.2018 is issued false.
