

### JUDGMENT

Accused is present before the court. The particulars of the offence is read over and explained to him to which he is pleading guilty for the said offence and prayed for showing leniency. He further submitted that, he is poor person having no source of income and prayed that minimum fine may be imposed. The fact is that charge-sheet not discloses that accused was selling the tobacco product to the person who is under 18 years of age. The offence is bailable and compoundable. The punishment to the offence is not exceeding Rs.200/-. Considering the nature of the offence and more particularly age and financial condition of accused, he is entitled for taking lenient view and therefore, I proceed to pass following order.

### ORDER

1. Accused is convicted of the offence punishable under **Section 6( b )** 24 of COPTA ACT 2003 and sentenced to pay a fine of **Rs.200/-** I/D. suffer S.I. for 01 (one) day.

2. Seized muddemal i.e. as mentioned in muddemal receipt is hereby confiscated. The I.O. shall take necessary action to dispose the same as per rule after appeal period is over. Copy of order be forwarded to Investigating Officer.
