ORDER AT EXH.1
(DT. 25.08.2025)

This is a complaint for issuing summons to accused for the offence punishable under section 341, 352, 354, 504, 506 r/w. 34 of IPC. Perused verification of complainant, report filed by PSO and heard Ld. Adv for the complainant.

2. Upon perusal of complaint, verification and documents on record, it appears that, the complainant have made specific allegations in complaint and verification regarding offence under section 341, 352, 354, 504, 506 r/w. 34 of IPC.

3. Complainant have stated on oath that, on 19.07.2014 during sowing, accused obstructed her and abused her in filthy language, held her hands and also threatened to kill her.

4. Perusal of report filed by PSO u/s 202 of Cr.P.C., shows that, PSO has recorded statement of nine witnesses including the applicant. All the statements prima-facie corroborates the contents of the application.

5. So far as the allegations regarding Sec.341 of IPC is concerned, in verification and in statements of witnesses, there is reference that, accused stopped the complainant from sowing the field by coming into the way of the same. However, nothing is mentioned that, complainant was prevented from proceeding beyond certain circumscribing limit and thus, ingredients of this section are not prima-facie made out.

6. So far as the allegations regarding Sec.352 & 354 of IPC is concerned, in verification and in statements of witnesses, there is reference that, accused held hands of the applicant and applied criminal force to her will ill intent and thus, ingredients of this section are prima-facie made out.

7. So far as the allegations regarding Sec.504 & 506 of IPC is concerned, in verification and in statements of witnesses, there is reference that, accused intentionally insulted the informant and threatened her with death and thus, ingredients of this section are prima-facie made out.

8. Considering complaint, verification and report of Sec.202 of Cr.P.C., I am of opinion that, there is a sufficient ground for proceeding against the accused for the offence mentioned above and hence, following is the order.

ORDER

1. **Vide Sec. 204 of Cr.P.C.**, issue summons to accused **1) Anil Pandhari Wankhade**, r/o New Tapdiya Nagar, Akola, Tq. & Dist. Akola and **2) Shankar Shivaram Ingale**, r/o Jambha Bk., Tq. Murtizapur, Dist. Akola for offence punishable under **section 352, 354, 504, 506 r/w 34 of IPC.**
