Examination-in-Chief by APP Shri. N. W. Sabardande for the State

On 24.1.2016, I was attached with Sub-District Government Hospital, Murtizapur as a Medical Officer. On that day N.P.C. Rajesh B.No. 1406 of Murtizapur (Rural) police station brought Ravindra Dnyaneshwar Gadbail and Chanda Ravindra Gadbail to the hospital to make injury report alongwith memo. Said memo now shown to me. It is the same. It bears my signature. The contents therein are true and correct. It is at **Ex.46**.

2. Accordingly, I had examined to the patient Chanda on 24.1.2016 at about 9.45 a.m.. She was complaining about pain in right forearm. I found following injuries.

1. Two abrasions on right forearm about 1x0,5 cm. each. The age of injury was fresh. The said injuries were simple in nature. Healing period was 3 to 5 days. Cause of injury was hard and blunt object.

2. Swelling over right forearm. I had advised x-ray of right forearm.

3. Thereafter, I had examined to the patient Ravindra on 24.1.2016 at about 9.50 a.m. In found C.L.W. over right temporal bone of scalf about 5 cm.x 2 cm.x1 cm. Age of injury was fresh. He has history of unconsciousness for ten minutes and nostria. I had advised surgeon opinion. Cause of injury hard and blunt object.

4. After examining the patient, I issued injury certificates. Now, the said certificates are shown to me. It bear my signatures, the signatures of N.P.C. and the patients. The contents there in are written by me. The same are true and correct. The said certificate are at **Exh.47 and 48** respectively. Now, Article A is shown to me wherein one KOPAI having wooden handle (instrument of doing agricultural work) is there. The injuries caused to the patients can be possible by means of said wooden handle (KOPAI).

5. I had referred the patient Ravindra to the Govt. Medical College, Akola for surgeon opinion.

Cross-examination by Advocate Shri C.S.Deshmukh for the accused.

6. It is true to say that, the injuries caused to the patient Ravindra and Chanda can be possible by falling on hard surface.

Cross-examination is over.

Re-examination nil.
