ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN R.C.C. NO.16/2004

1. Perused the record and proceeding. It appears that in the present case the accused has been prosecuted for the offence punishable under section 406, 34 of I.P.C. It appears that since beginning the accused is absent. On several times N.B.W. were issued against the accused. However, it could not be served. Hence, proclamation under section 82 and under section 83 of Cr.P.C. for the attachment of the property of accused were issued. But same could not be executed. It also appears that accused is resident of Raipur.

2. On perusal of record it appears that inspite of all above necessary procedure prosecution failed to secure the presence of accused. The matter is kept on dormant file since one year by issuing standing warrant. Hence, matter be sent to Record Room, District Court, Akola.
