**ORDER AT EXH.-28**

1. This is an application filed by the accused for suspension of sentence u/s 389(3) of Cr.PC.
2. Read the application and say of APP.
3. Heard the Ld. Advocate for the accused.
4. It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate for the accused that, the accused is convicted for the offence u/s 354 of IPC, and he is punished with imprisonment of one year and fine of Rs 2000/- and in default of payment of fine accused to suffer simple imprisonment for further period of one month. Accused wants to challenge the order and prefer the appeal against said Judgment before the appellate Court. Accused is permanent resident of Akola District and have no criminal antecedents. Accused is ready to abide-by any condition that may be imposed by the court while suspending the sentence and till filling of appeal, he be release on bail.
5. Accused is convicted for the offence u/s 354 of IPC, and he is punished with imprisonment of one year and fine of Rs 2000/- and in default of payment of fine accused to suffer simple imprisonment for further period of one month.
6. The offence is non-bailable one and accused was on bail during trial. Today accused is present in Court, after pronouncement of Judgment, along with his counsel and wants to prefer appeal against the judgment and till then he be released on bail.
7. Wherever, there is remedy to file appeal, it is right of every convicted person to file the same. Therefore, it is necessary and expedient to release the accused on bail and to suspend the sentence till the statutory period of filling of appeal.

**ORDER**

1. Application at Exh.28 is allowed.
2. The substantive sentence passed in RCC No. 143/2020 by Judgment and order dated on 07.03.2026 is suspended till the period of limitation for preferring an appeal against the same, till 07.04.2026
3. Today accused is released on his PB of Rs.25000/- and SB each of Rs.25000/-.
4. The order of suspension of sentence will not be extended after the aforesaid period, on any count by this Court.
