State Government Vs. Lokesh Nagorao Jadhav and 3

C H A R G E

(1)(a) I, **Shri Sudhakar V. Yarlagaadda, Principal District and Sessions Judge Amravati**, hereby charge you

1. Lokesh Nagorao Jadhav Age 21, Occ.: education,
 2. Chabubai Nagorao Jadhav, Age: 39, Occ.:Police Patil
 3. Jitesh Nagorao Jadhav,, Age 20, Occ.:Labour
- All R/o Salora Tasre, Tq.Teosa, Dist.Amravati.

as follows;

1. That first you all in furtherance of your common intention with deceased accused Ramdas Nathuji Chavhan, on 28.02.2020 at about 8.30 to 9.00 pm, at Salora Tasre, Tq.Teosa, Dist.Amravati unlawfully entered in the house of the informant Hiralal Rathod's son-in-law Gunwant Chavhan with intention and after making preparation to cause hurt and to commit his murder and dragged him out of the house and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 452 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, and within my cognizance.
2. That secondly, in furtherance of common intention you alongwith deceased accused Ramdas, on the above mentioned date and time near the bridge, did the act -armed with deadly weapons of iron rod, wooden stick, iron rod with grill studded wheel and sickle voluntarily caused grievous hurt to his head with such intention or knowledge and under such circumstances that had the act of yours caused death of Ramdas, you would have been guilty of murder and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 307 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, and within my cognizance, and
3. Thirdly, you, all in furtherance of common intention with deceased accused Ramdas, on the above mentioned date, time and place committed murder by intentionally or knowingly causing the death of said Ramdas, and thereby committed an offence punishable under Section 302 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code and within my cognizance.

And I hereby direct that you be tried by this Court on the said charge.
