It is an application under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nyaya Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (In short B.N.S.S.) for regular bail, in connection with Crime No.138/2026, registered with Rajapeth Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 109, 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2. Perused the application and reply given by Investigation Officer through Ld. APP.
3. Heard both the Ld. Advocates.
4. Considering the submission of the parties, it appears that the name and role of the applicant is specifically narrated in the FIR. The applicant assaulted the informant by knife. As per record and case diary, it appears that the applicant is having criminal background. Number of criminal cases (06) are registered against the applicant. As per injury certificate, injured sustained stab injury. The applicant and the informant reside in a same locality. Therefore, the possibility of tampering of evidence and pressurizing the informant cannot be denied. On the other hand, the offence under Section 109 is serious and punishable upto life. Therefore, though charge-sheet is filed, the applicant is not entitled for the bail. I, therefore, pass following order :-

ORDER

Criminal Bail Application No. 487/2026 is rejected.
