It is second bail application under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nyaya Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (In short B.N.S.S.) for regular bail, in connection with Crime No.138/2026, registered with Rajapeth Police Station for the offences punishable under Sections 109, 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.

2. Perused the application and reply given by Investigation Officer through learned APP.

3. Heard both the learned Advocates.

4. Considering the submission of the parties, it appears that the first bail application was rejected on the grounds - (i) Role of the applicant, (ii) seriousness of the offence, (iii) conduct of the applicant and (iv) the stage of the investigation. The present application is filed on the ground that the charge-sheet is filed. However, nothing pleaded or argued regarding grounds No. (i) to (iii).

5. The name and role of the applicant is specifically narrated in the FIR. The applicant assaulted the informant by knife. As per record and case diary, it appears that the main accused of the crime Prashant Chaware is having criminal background. Number of

criminal cases are registered against the said accused. The applicant voluntarily associated with the above accused and played the vital role in the crime. As per injury certificate, injured sustained to stab injury. On the other hand, the offence under Section 109 is serious and punishable upto life. Therefore, at this stage, though the informant was discharged and charge-sheet is filed, the applicant is not entitled for the bail. I, therefore, pass following order :-

ORDER

Criminal Bail Application No.482/2026 is rejected.
