COMMON ORDER BELOW EXH.14 AND 16
(Dated : 08.04.2026)

1. In view of amended provisions of the Motor Vehicles Act, claim for seeking compensation arising out of vehicular accident needs to be filed within six months from the date of occurrence of the accident. Therefore, the petitioner claims for condonation of delay whereas the respondent company prays for dismissal of the claim petition as it is hopelessly barred by limitation.
2. The respondent company opposes for condonation of delay whereas the petitioner opposes the dismissal of the petition on account of delay.
3. The issue is sub-judice before before the Hon'ble Supreme Court and at present there is a sigh of relief for such petitions which can be worked out on merit keeping issue of limitation in abeyance. Hence, both the applications are disposed of. Issue of limitation is kept in abeyance. Matter to proceed ahead.
