

ORDER ON MEMO

ORDER

Accordingly the respondent No.1 is hereby directed to deposit the amount of Rs.2,00,000/- in the court as agreed in the joint memo. After depositing, entire compensation amount of Rs.2,00,000/- shall be released in favour of petitioner with proper identification. The joint memo is part and parcel of the compromise award.

Draw the award accordingly.
