



ORDER BELOW EXH. 1

(Passed on this 01st day of April 2026)

This is an application filed by the applicants for grant of heirship certificate under clause 2 of the Bombay Regulation VIII Act, 1827.

2. In brief, the case of applicants is that, deceased Mahadevrao Narayanrao Kadu and Zingunabai Mahadevrao Kadu resident of Borala, Tq. Daryapur. Dist. Amravati were husband and wife. They died respectively on 30.11.2009 and 20.03.1999. Applicants No. 1 and 2 are sons, applicant No. 3 is daughter-in-law, applicants No. 4 and 5 grand-sons and applicant No. 6 is married daughter of deceased Mahadevrao Narayanrao Kadu and Zingunabai Mahadevrao Kadu. Husband of applicant No. 3 i.e. another son of deceased Mahadevrao and Zingunabai, namely Ganesh Mahadevrao Kadu is also died on 22.01.2024. Applicants further contends that, after demise of said Shrikrushna Manohar present applicants are his only legal heirs. Applicants required heirship certificate for official work, education, government schemes, etc.

3. On receipt of application, objections were called from public by issuing citation notice and publication in daily newspaper.

4. Apropos the said service, reports have been received. The report of the paper publication "Mangalprahar" dated 24/02/2026 is

filed on record below **Exh.21**. It also fortifies the factum of service. No objections were received within requisite period. Hence, the application is uncontested.

5. In order to prove the application, the applicant no. 4 has given evidence below **Exh.11** in which he has reiterated the contents of the application. As the application is uncontested, his oral evidence has gone unchallenged. Hence, it can be relied upon. The documents i.e. the death certificate of deceased Mahadevrao Kadu, Zingunabai Kadu and Ganesh Kadu filed at **Exh. 12 to 14**, Verified copies of Adhar cards of applicants at **Exh. 15 to 20**, coupled with the said unchallenged oral testimony further supports the applicants' claim. There are no other legal heirs of deceased Mahadevrao Narayanrao Kadu and Zingunabai Mahadevrao Kadu after their demise, except present applicants. Hence, in view of emerging evidence, the applicants are entitled for legal heirship certificate. Hence, I pass the following order :

ORDER

1. The application (Exh.1) is allowed.
2. Applicants 1) Ramesh Mahadev Kadu, 2) Vishvas Mahadev Kadu, 3) Ratna Ganesh Kadu, 4) Vinod Ganesh Kadu, 5) Vilas Ganesh Kadu, 6) Varsha Sanjay Bhagat are hereby declared legal heirs of deceased Mahadevrao Narayanrao Kadu and Zingunabai Mahadevrao Kadu.
3. Issue Heirship Certificate accordingly in the name of above applicants after payment of requisite Court fees stamp.
4. The application is disposed of accordingly.
