COMMITMENT ORDER:

The above named accused have been sent up by the SHO,

Police Station, Baldev Nagar (Ambala), to face trial for commission of offences punishable under sections 379-A, 201 of IPC.

2. Brief facts of the case of the prosecution are that, on 20.02.2023, complainant Ravi Jain w/o Prem Bhushan Jain, r/o House no.213, Sector-7, Ambala City filed a complaint before the police, alleging therein that, on 20.02.2022 at about 06:00 p.m, complainant was returning home by rickshaw and when she reached near Police DAV School, Ambala City, two boys came from behind on a motorcycle and the pillion rider snatched her purse containing Rs.4700/- and a mobile phone Redmi note-10 having sim no.97293-36238, IEMI no.868348056323532 and 868348056323540, lying in her lap and fled away from the spot quickly. She could not note down number and make of the motorcycle. She moved a complaint in this regard to the police. It was requested that necessary action be taken against the accused person.

3. On the basis of said complaint, formal FIR was registered. Investigation was commenced. During investigation, site plan of place of occurrence was prepared. Statements of witnesses were recorded. Accused were arrested. After completion of all formalities of investigation, challan against present accused person was filed before the Court.

4. Copes of challan were supplied to both the accused free of costs, as envisaged under Section 207 Cr.P.C.

5. Heard. From the evidence collected by the police during the investigation, as reflected in final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C., a prima facie case u/ss. 379-A, 201 of IPC is made out against the accused. Since, the offence punishable under Sections 379-A of IPC is exclusively triable by the Court of Sessions, therefore, the present challan is committed to the Court of learned Sessions, Ambala for 06.09.2023. Accused above-named, who are in custody, are ordered to be produced before the Court of the learned Sessions Judge, Ambala on 06.09.2023, at 10.00 a.m., sharp. Ahlmad of this court is directed to send the case file, complete in all respects, to the court of the Hon'ble Sessions, Judge, Ambala, well in advance. Since the present order has been dictated and pronounced in the presence of learned Asstt. Public Prosecutor, therefore, no separate notification is required to be issued to the State. List of witnesses be prepared accordingly.
