

ORDER BELOW EXH.22 IN PWDVA. NO.50/2025**Farheen V/S Salman & Others**

The application is moved by the non-applicants for setting aside no-cross order passed against them on 06.01.2026.

2] It is stated that, the said order was not reflected in roznama. So, they had no knowledge of the said order. Due to medical treatment the non-applicant no.1 was not present on that day. But, it is prayed that, for proper adjudication of the case, the application be allowed.

3] The applicant filed reply to the present application stating that, no sufficient reason mentioned. The non-applicants had knowledge of the order. But, they intentionally prolonged the matter to harass the applicant. Application is totally vague. Hence, it be rejected with heavy costs.

4] Perused the application and its reply. Considered the submissions. No doubt, there is no cross order against the non-applicants. But, for proper adjudication of the case and in the interest of justice an opportunity is required to be given to the non-applicants. Hence, the following order:

ORDER

The application (Exh.22) is allowed and the order dated 06.01.2026 is set aside subject to cost of Rs.500/- being paid to the applicant.
